



CREFOP hosts the final event and meeting of the RECREATE project in Bucharest.

RECREATE partners presented the results, training tools and other career guidance resources to national and European stakeholders of career counselling, i.e. clients, counsellors, public and private organisations. The RECREATE Project introduces innovative tools and solutions such as the use of social media in career counselling.

The final event was held in Bucharest on July 7 with more than 110 attendees representing the diverse cohort of career guidance stakeholders. The conference was a unique opportunity to promote the Recreate Platform and adoption of related resources beyond the project lifetime.

Partners described the issues of European labour market and the main challenges in the framework of the RECREATE project, such as the lack of professional standards for the career counsellor profile and need for improved in-service training programmes.

At the final project meeting, partners also exchanged views on the Intellectual Output 5 "Policy Recommendation on Career Guidance and Counselling". The Cypriot partner ENOROS presented the final draft of policy recommendations on the professional profile of counsellors, enhanced counselling through social media and targeted career counselling techniques.
