



National validation phase

Under the RECREATE project 5 Intellectual outputs were developed. The consortium composed of 7 partners from 6 European countries elaborated high-quality outcomes related to career advisory services (counsellors and job seekers everyday cooperation).

To achieve the goals planned under the project all the partners were to analyze the current situation of career advisors and counsellors in each project country to describe the needs of target groups. All the reports were the results of both a desk and a field research (the desk research was aiming at describing the current legal and political framework for the career advisors and counsellors, while the field research aimed at collecting the opinion of a representative sample from this target group in terms of the way they provide their services and how they think this could be improved). At the end of the diagnostic phase all the reports were summarized and the diagnose for the subject was developed in the “Policy Recommendations on Career Guidance and Counselling” addressed to social partners and policy makers who can play a significant role on facilitating and improving the day-to-day work of career advisors and counsellors.

In order to collect the various opinions about the platform each partner had to get involved a number of counsellors and job seekers (222 users) to validate the platform, interactive tools for career advisors available on the platform. The counsellors were also asked to evaluate the content of blended-training they all were attending. The validation period lasted for 6 months and each partner planned individually its validation stage. The evaluation questionnaires included sections as: technical issues, content issues, social tools and open questions to enable all the responders to share their opinion about any issue they wish to. The representative group was asked to test the functionality of the platform in order to collect the feedback that will be the basis along with the final version of the platform will be build. Overall, the validation of the outputs shows extremely positive results – the responders really appreciated the idea of the platform and materials available on it. Career advisors stated that the content of the platform is a valuable source to enhance their knowledge while the job seekers agreed that the diagnostic tools are user-friendly and useful to evaluate their skills and competencies.
